- **Networking Opportunity:** Connect with investors at Gitex Africa from May 29-31, opening doors to potential investment opportunities and partnerships.
- **Supernova Challenge:** Participants will have the chance to compete in the Supernova Challenge, with the opportunity to win up to \$50,000. This competition is a significant highlight of the program, showcasing the best of the global innovation.

Candidates must submit their applications by Friday, 22 March 2024. <u>Late submissions will not be considered.</u>

- Detail your innovative project idea, your motivation for joining the program, and how you believe it will change the tech industry.

- Please accompany your application with a short 30-second elevator pitch video. This video should include a compelling and intriguing introduction, value proposition, evidence, differentiator, and a call to action. Please ensure the video is clear, concise, and reflects your genuine enthusiasm.

Eligibility:

- Individuals passionate about technology and innovation;
- Candidates should be in an advanced stage, and must have at least a Proof of Concept (POC) or a Minimum Viable Product (MVP) to showcase;
- Candidates must be available to commit to the entire duration of the program, including travel and participation in the bootcamp, networking opportunities with investors, and the challenge at Gitex Africa.

N.B. Applicants' projects <u>must</u> be in an advanced development stage.

All applicants must have at least a Proof of Concept (POC) or a Minimum Viable Product (MVP) to ensure they can fully engage with the program's opportunities, including the bootcamp, investor networking, and the Supernova Challenge at Gitex Africa.

Having a POC or MVP demonstrates a certain level of commitment and progress in your project, making it possible for investors and mentors to provide more specific, actionable advice and support.

We believe this foundation will significantly enhance the learning experience, the potential for collaboration, and the overall impact of your participation in the innovation hub.

Selection Process:

The selection of the participants will be based on :

- The innovation potential of the project,
- Commitment to the technology sector,
- Ability to benefit from and contribute to the BMAQ Innovation Hub program.
- Good command of international languages for the smooth running of projects.

Use this opportunity to accelerate your career, network with industry leaders, secure potential investment, and compete for a substantial prize.
